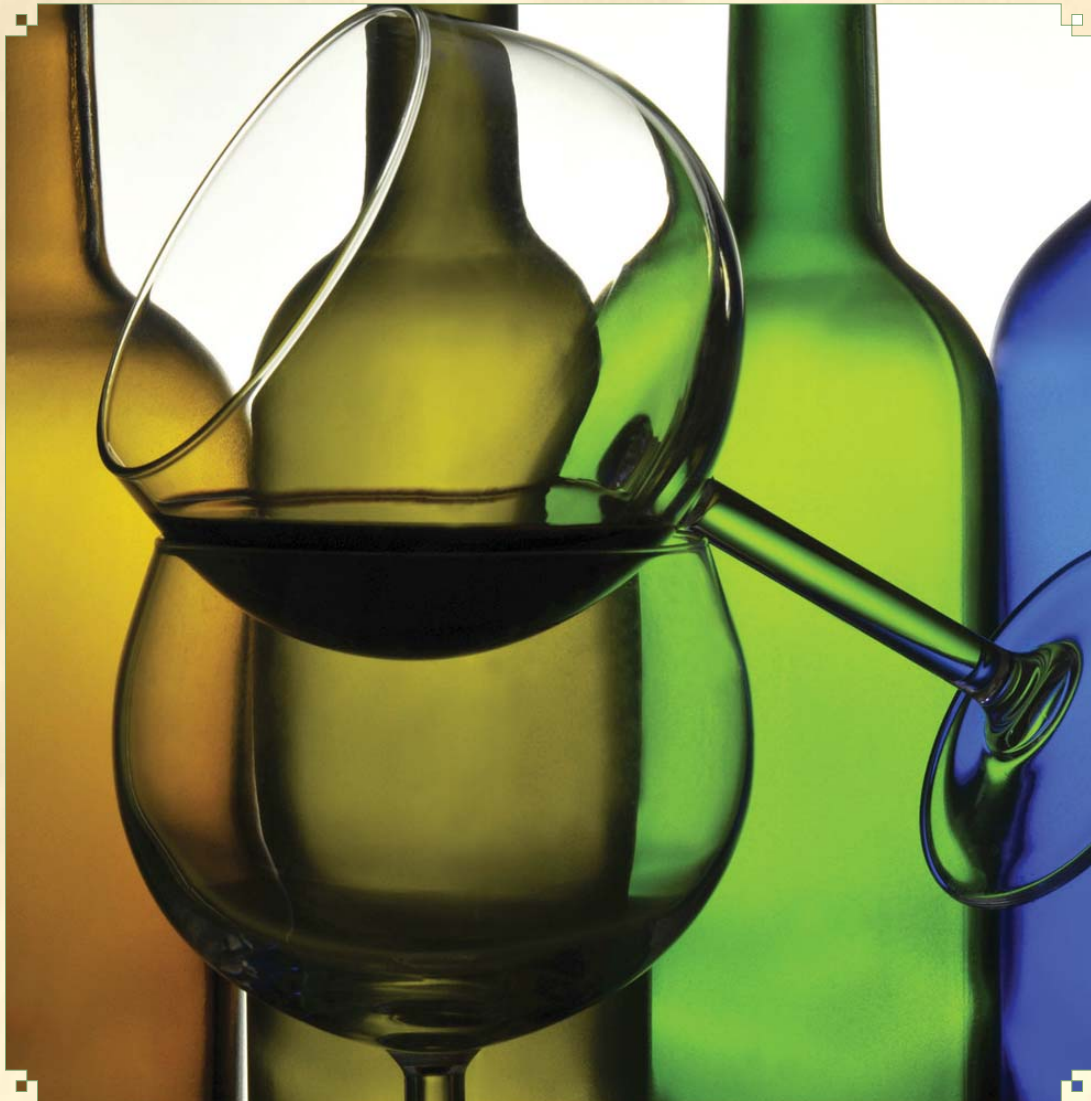


Beverage Guidelines



Beverage Guidelines

1. **Host Bar Service**

The client is invoiced for all liquor consumed during the event. TCU Place provides all liquor, beer, wine and liqueur products available from our current stock, as well as bar staff, bartenders, glasses, ice, mix, bar equipment, and all related condiments. Service charge and GST is applied to total amount invoiced.

2. **Cash Bar Service**

TCU Place provides liquor, beer, wine and liqueur products available from our current stock, bar staff and bartenders with all the necessary condiments.

Cash Bar Service includes Pepsi, Diet Pepsi, Ginger Ale, 7-Up, Soda Water, Tonic Water, Ice Water, Clamato Juice, Orange Juice, Seasonings, Limes, and Celery.

Please ask your Event Coordinator about current prices for standard and premium cash bar service.

All liquor prices include 5% Provincial Sales Tax.

3. **Permit Bar Service** *(not available during the Christmas Season)*

TCU Place authorizes Permit Bars only when a complete dinner menu has been selected from our menu or created by our caterers for your event. The client must purchase a Special Occasion Permit from the SLGA for the room(s), outlining the times and liquor allowed on the premises. Permit Alcohol Only.

For Permit Bar Services, TCU Place charges a corkage fee per person and bartender charges.

Full Bar Corkage \$6.00 per person attending the event

Beer & Wine Corkage..... \$5.00

Wine & Champagne Corkage..... \$4.50

Wine only Corkage \$3.50

Tray Service: Labour charges will apply. Please ask your Event Coordinator for a quote.

Corkage

Corkage applies to every person attending the event 2 years and older. We will charge for the guaranteed amount of people or actual attendees (whichever is greater). The corkage also applies to additional people that attend the latter part of an event, but have not eaten dinner.

TCU Place provides glasses, ice, mix, bar equipment, and condiments for the corkage fee.

Bartender Charges

In all cases, bartenders are charged back to the client; one bartender / 100 people.

Please ask your Event Coordinator for current wage rates.

Liquor Delivery

Liquor must be delivered 48 hours prior to the event, and must be accompanied with a SLGA Special Occasion Permit and receipts. Unconsumed liquor, empty and partial bottles must be removed from the premises at the end of the event. Service charges and GST are applied to the corkage charge.

Ticket sellers can be provided upon request. Ask your Event Coordinator for pricing.
